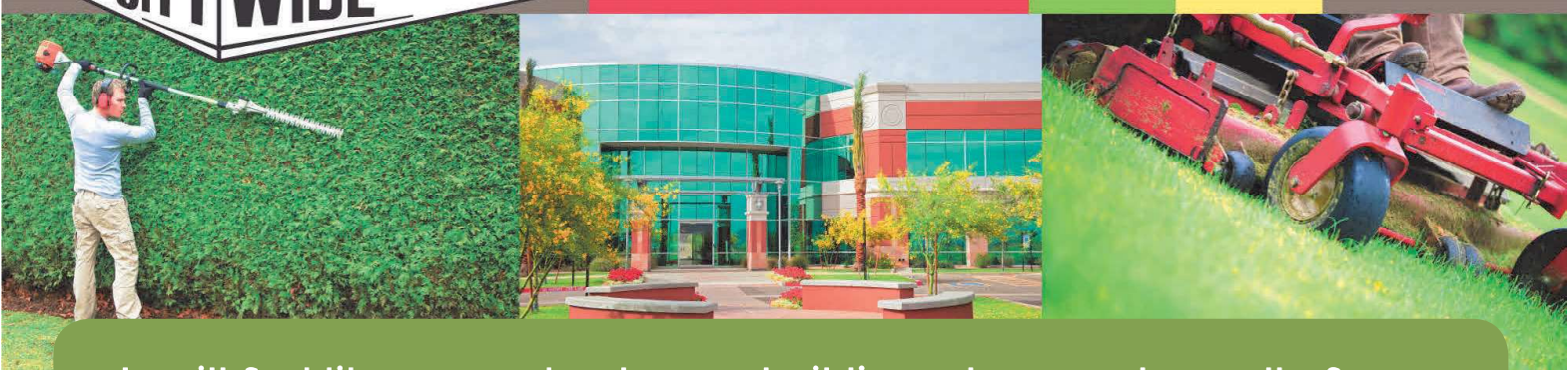


# What's Next?
